


SKILL BUILDING: 4 Flying Geese At a Time








BLOCK SIZE				
9" Finished	(4) 3 1/8"x 3 1/8"	(1) 5"x 5"	(4) 2 3/4"x 2 3/4"	(1) 5 3/4"x 5 3/4"
12" Finished	(4) 3 7/8"x 3 7/8"	(1) 6 1/2"x 6 1/2"	(4) 3 1/2"x 3 1/2"	(1) 7 1/4"x 7 1/4"

FLYING GEESE

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (4) White squares (Diagram 1). Layer 2 White squares on top of the Gold square with right sides together as shown. The White squares will overlap slightly. Sew the pairs together, stitching 1/4" away from the drawn line on each side (Diagram 2). Cut the pair apart on the drawn line. (Diagram 3). Press units open.




2. Place the another White square on top of the unit from the previous step as shown. Sew the pairs together, stitching 1/4" on each side of the drawn line (Diagram 5). Cut the pair along the drawn line (Diagram 6). Press the seam allowances toward the triangle points to make 2 Flying Geese units. Repeat with the other triangle half unit from step 3 to make 2 more units.



ASSEMBLE BLOCK #1

- 1. Lay out (4) Flying Geese, (1) Grey center square and (4) Green corner squares as shown below.
- 2. Sew the blocks together to make 3 rows.
- 3. Sew the rows together to complete the block. Press all seams.



BLOCK #1 is: 9 1/2" x 9 1/2" OR 12 1/2" x 12 1/2" unfinished
